Scientific Writing for Agricultural Economists

Time period	From 28 th to 31 st of May, 2019
Location	Kyiv School of Economics (KSE), Dmytrivska St, 92-94, 01135, Kyiv, Ukraine
Lecturer	Prof. Dr. Stephan von Cramon-Taubadel (University of Goettingen, Germany)
Course description	This course is designed to help PhD students in agricultural economics improve the skills that are required to communicate and ultimately publish scientific research in refereed journals.
Course outline	1 Introduction: Why 'scientific writing'; 2. The journals landscape in agricultural economics; 3. Writing, submitting, revising, publishing and reviewing scientific papers – what is expected of you? 4. Writing papers in English – suggestions, avoiding common mistakes, encouragement; 5. Good scientific practice – plagiarism and other pitfalls.
Format	Two lecture blocks: each day from 9:00 to 12:00 and from 13:30 to 16:00.
Grading	To be certified, the participants are supposed to attend all lectures and write a short abstract (250 words) using some of the methods and writing techniques discussed and practiced during the course. A deadline for submitting the abstract several weeks after the end of the course will be decided with the students on the first day of the course. Credit points: 3 CP
Language	English
Requirements	Current PhD students in agricultural/food economics, general economics, or related fields. Applications from researchers and academics are also invited. The course will be in English and a solid command of the English language is expected. This is not an English course! Also it is not required, but it is better if the participants bring their own laptops!
Application	Online applications (in English language) should be submitted through Online Application Form . For online submission, visit the website (click to follow the link or open the link in browser) . Application submissions should contain the following documents in pdf format: (1) Curriculum vitae, (2) Letter of motivation (up to 1 page), (3) Title page with abstract of your paper (maximum up to 300 words), and (4) Scanned copies of relevant certificates of Bachelor's, Master's, Specialist's or Doctor's Degree (PhD or Candidate of Sciences) in pdf files (no larger than 2 MB for each certificate). Online applications period ends on Monday, 6 May, 2019, at 12 PM (24:00) Eastern European Time!
